Highway Report:

The highway crew has been mowing roadsides and working on roads.

Resident Amanda Barber reminded the Superintendent of Highway to clean the mower between Roads to help stop the spread of Japanese knotweeds by cleaning the mower.

Resident John Slocum asked KJ Superintendent of Highway if he had prepared to stop ahead signs, they should be used during road work to help with the liability of the Town.

Superintendent Alnutt wants to sell the 2500 Ram pickup for \$24,300 and the 2014 Ford 350 for \$14,100. The highway needs a large metal storage cabinet.

Unfinished Business:

Supervisor Clough is concerned that the cables that power our phone and internet are missing, the wire is unsecured on the building. The supervisor will contact Point Board Band to come to fix it.

The Town has a new Bookkeeper Michael Rosenthal. He and Supervisor Clough have been working on the New York Retirement, they still need more information on the employees.

Councilperson Tillotson reported reflective signs for house numbers could be purchased at Lowes, also if you are from Marathon or McGraw you could check with those Fire Dept. at a cost to the residents.
